Preparing for the GFLI Branded Data-in project



GFLI tip: Read the GFLI Methodology V3.0 prior to the start of a Branded Data-In project.



Defining a data-in project using the project proposal

The project proposal contains information about goal, scope and approach. The data use conditions should be defined. Optional: Present the project proposal in the Technical Management Committee (TMC)

Action required by applying company

Data collection and modelling

Activities defined in the project plan may be executed. These activities include collecting data from defined sources and modelling the data. Documentation should be included in the data collection report. Following information is required:

- Goal, scope, system boundaries and functional unit
- Allocation
- Data collection and data quality ranking
- Emissions modelling (if relevant)
- Background data used
- Impact assessment

Sign license agreement

Sign the license agreement via Docu-Sign and if, and if so, on which type of data and level of sharing is preferred. After GFLI signed the License agreement, the internal review can take place.

Action required by applying company and GFLI

Share required information with GFLI

After completing step 1 - 4, your data is ready for the internal review! Please share the following information with your GFLI contact person.

-  Data collection report
-  LCIA results in the GFLI template (xls.file)
-  LCI data

Action required by applying company



GFLI tip: To prevent delay in database integration, make sure the LCIA data is included in the GFLI template. Contact the GFLI secretariat for the template.

Review process



For your information: The GFLI LCA expert may need additional information to perform the review. Any missing information for a successful branded data process can be added during the internal review process.

Performing the internal review

After sharing the required information with GFLI, the internal review will take place. The internal review is performed by GFLI's LCA expert.

Receive Internal Review Statement by GFLI!

Performing the external review

After receiving GFLI's internal review statement, proceed with the external review. It is the company's responsibility to contact an external reviewer and perform the external review. A list of approved external reviewers is available on the [GFLI-website](#). Please share the external review statement with your GFLI contact person.

Receive Letter of Confirmation by GFLI!

Database integration (optional)

Congratulations! Your branded data product is aligned with the GFLI methodology. Branded data can now be integrated into the GFLI database according to the preferred publication option as indicated in the license agreement.
